WHAT, WHERE, WHEN

What day does 'The Longhill Burn' take place?

The Longhill Burn takes place on Saturday 15 July 2017. Please arrive at 9:30pm.

What is 'The Longhill Burn'?

We will gather together for music, dancing, surprises and the lighting of a huge and beautiful bonfire.

The Longhill burn will celebrate the area, fuelling the future.

Where does 'The Longhill Burn' take place?

The Longhill Burn takes place on **Eastmount Playing Fields**, which are located behind **Eastmount Community Recreation Centre**, Waveney Road, Longhill, HU8 9NB.
Access to the site is via the **Main Gates** to Eastmount
Community Recreation Centre on Waveney Road.
Once inside the gates you will be directed to the bonfire site. Please follow instructions from our team, and do not stray from the group.

What time does 'The Longhill Burn' begin and end? Entry to the Bonfire site is from **9:30pm**. The show will end at approximately 10:30pm.

WHAT, WHERE, WHEN

What preparations do I need to make?

The Longhill Burn is free to attend, and no booking is required.

We are expecting thousands of people to attend the bonfire, which takes place on Eastmount Playing Fields after dark. Although lighting will be provided the ground may be muddy and uneven under foot, so please take care and ensure you and your group are wearing sensible footwear.

Is there allocated seating?

General seating is not available.

Please do not bring your own chairs as they will not be permitted.

CHILDREN & DOGS

Is 'The Longhill Burn' suitable for children?

Yes, it is suitable for all ages.

Children under the age of 16 must be accompanied by an adult.

Are dogs allowed?

There is amplified music and pyrotechnic effects used as part of The Longhill Burn, so it may be a frightening experience for animals. With the exception of assistance dogs, animals will not be admitted.

GETTING TO EASTMOUNT PLAYING FIELDS

How do I get to Easmount Playing Fields?

Parking is extremely limited around Eastmount Playing Fields, so we advise use of public transport or travelling by foot where possible.

Public Transport

We are encouraging the use of public transport for anyone travelling from outside of the Longhill estate. The following bus services from the city centre make stops in the Longhill estate or just outside of it on Holderness Road:

11 Stage Coach (last bus from Apollo PH (Holderness Road – 00:50)

56 EYMS (last bus from Longhill Estate (Wansbeck Road – 23:04)

57 EYMS (last bus from Longhill Estate (Wansbeck Road – 22:44)

By Foot or Cycling

Please head to the entrance gate to Eastmount Community Recreation Centre on Waveney Road. This is the only entrance to the site. Please follow directional signage and look out for members of our team who can help you find your way.

GETTING TO EASTMOUNT PLAYING FIELDS

Parking

There will be limited parking available for blue badge holders on a first come first serve basis. This is located at Eastmount Community Recreation Centre on Waveney Road.

Parking is <u>extremely limited</u> and non-residents are discouraged from parking on the Longhill estate. Instead, there is parking available at:

TOILETS & ACCESSIBILITY

Are there toilets nearby?

We have arranged for temporary toilets, including accessible and gender neutral toilets, to be available.

SITE TERMS & CONDITIONS

- Animals, with the exception of assistance dogs, are not permitted.
- No alcohol is permitted within the site.
- Food and beverage items (excluding alcohol) may be brought to the site for personal consumption only.
 Food and beverage will not be for sale within the site.
- Children under 16 must be accompanied by a parent or guardian.
- Re-admission once the gates have closed is not permitted.

- In the unlikely event that attendance is oversubscribed the organisers reserve the right to limit entry in the interest of public safety.
- Latecomers will not be admitted.
- Admission to the site is at your own risk and the organisers have no liability whatsoever for any loss, damage, death, or injury to you or your property which is not caused by its negligence.
- You are not permitted to use professional audio, video and/or photographic equipment within the site without the express permission of the organisers.
