The 'Back to Ours' project aims to engage non-engagers and low-engagers of performing arts, growing their confidence as a consumer of culture, and enabling them to take risks in what they choose to see. In the longer-term the hope is they will seek out and feel more able to attend cultural events elsewhere (including city centre venues).

This is done through creating a series of temporary performance venues within existing community facilities, which are both local and familiar, e.g. schools, community centres, social clubs and a shopping centre. These venues host a range of performing arts, including comedy, live music, dance, contemporary circus, cabaret, and spoken word, as well as a cinema experience with a difference. Ticket prices are kept low, costing between £2.50 and £10.

This combination of approaches seeks to overcome geographical, financial and institutional barriers to engagement.
