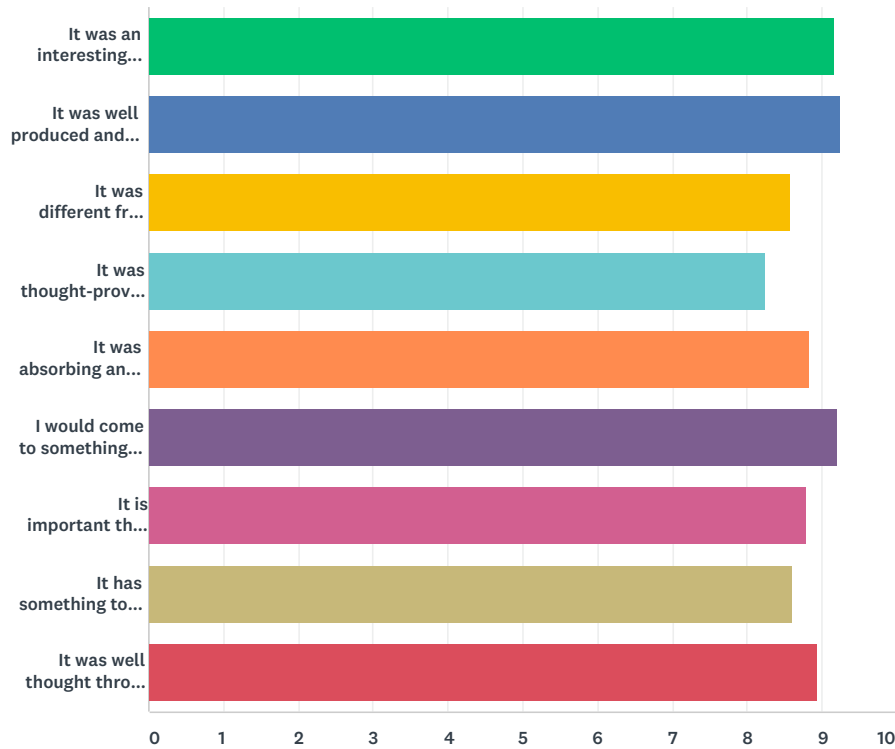

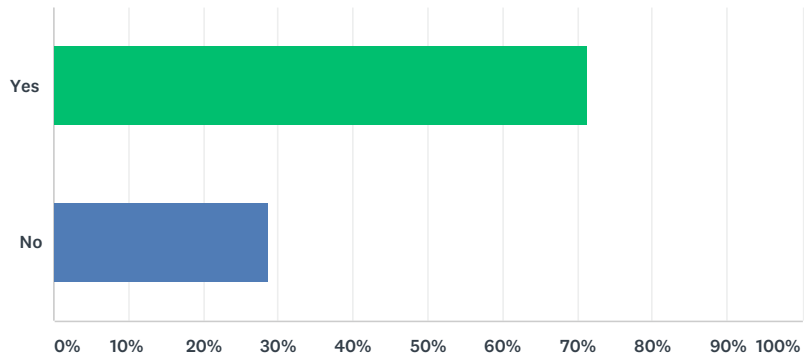

Q7 Do you live in Hull?

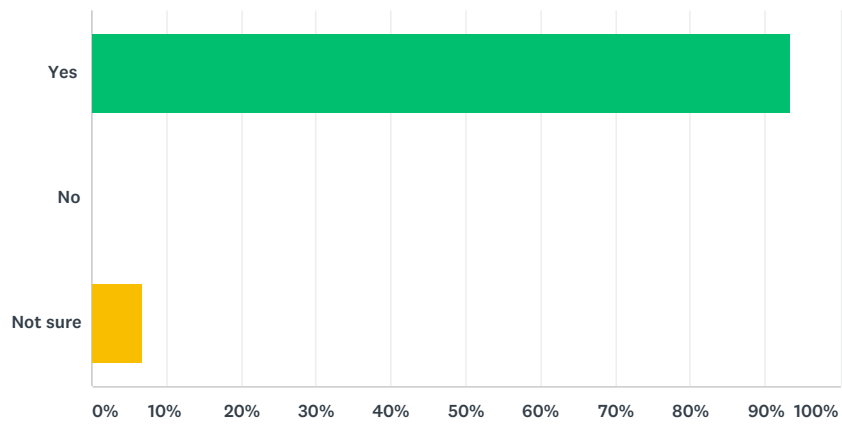

Q8 Have you been to, or are you planning to attend or take part in other events and activities programmed for Hull UK City of Culture 2017?

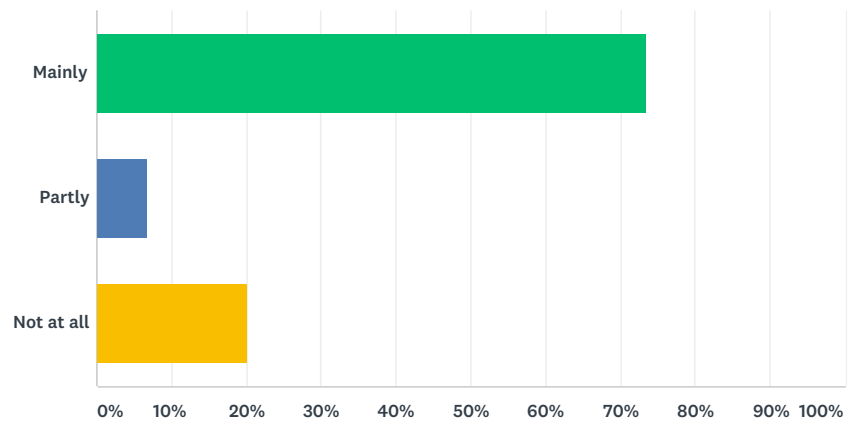

Q9 Was your visit to the City Centre on the day you attended All We Wanted Was Everything mainly, partly or not at all due to the event?

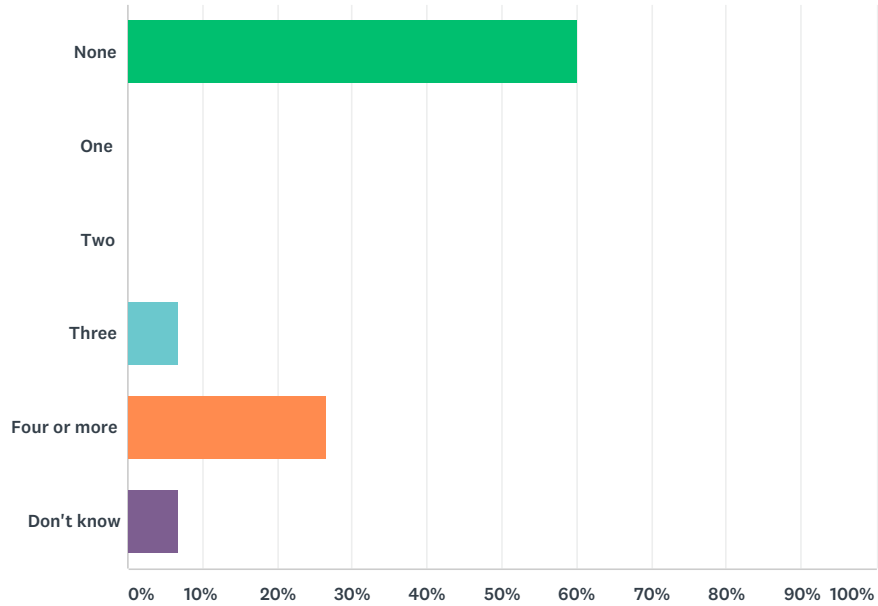

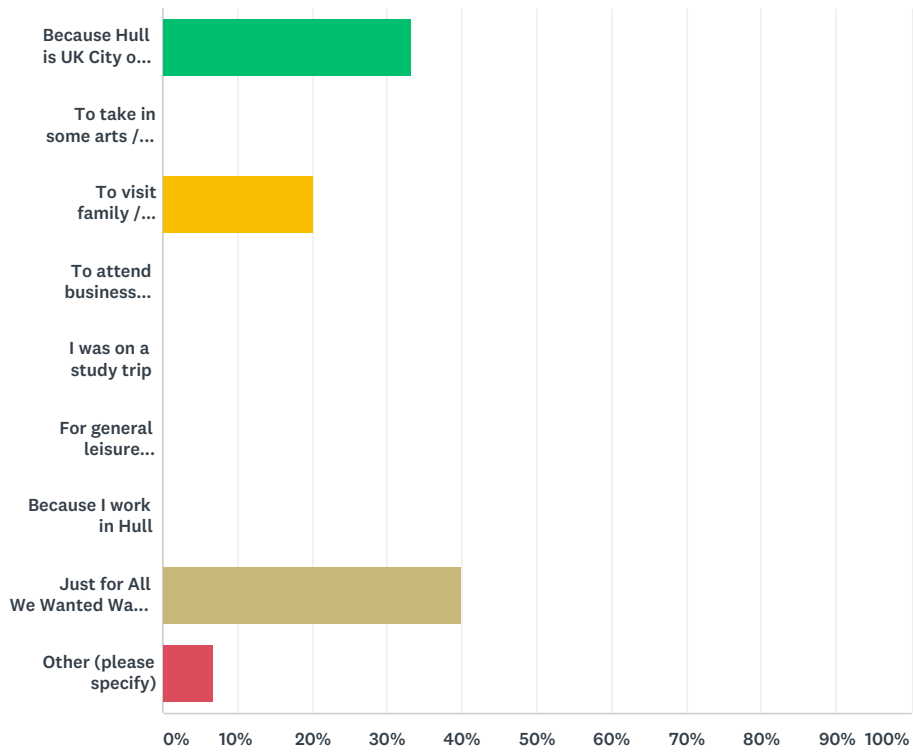

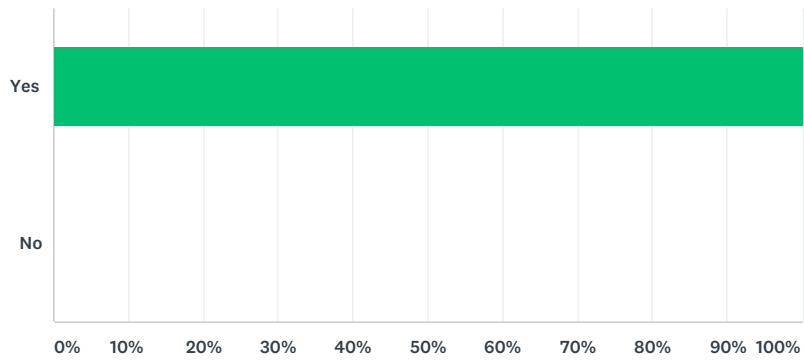

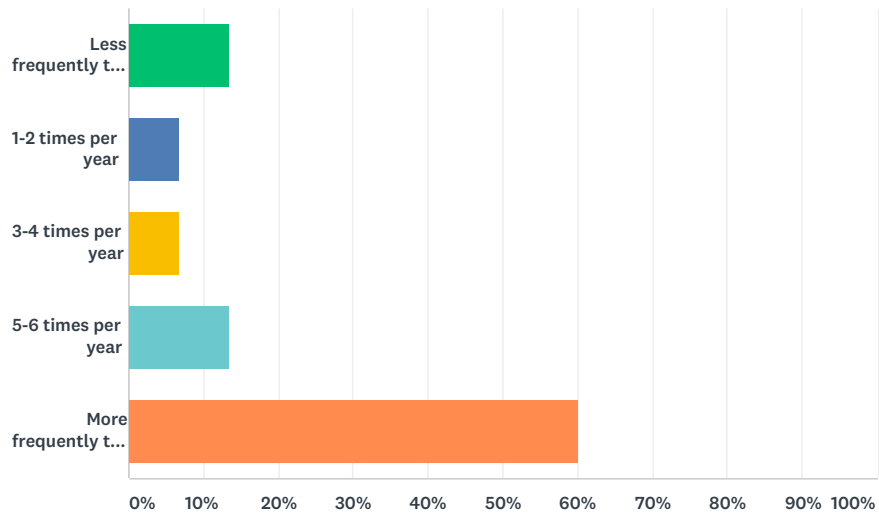

Q13 On average, over the course of a year, how frequently do you visit Hull?

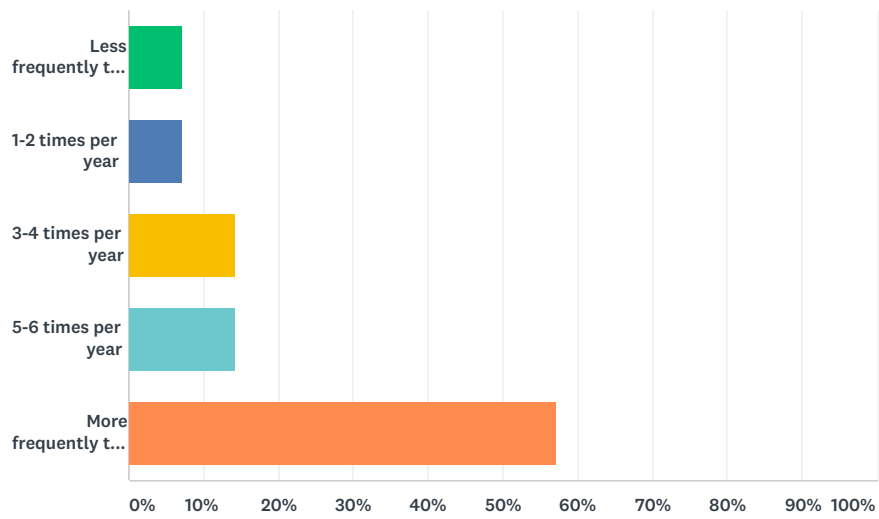

Q14 Based on your experience during this visit, how frequently do you think you will visit Hull in future?

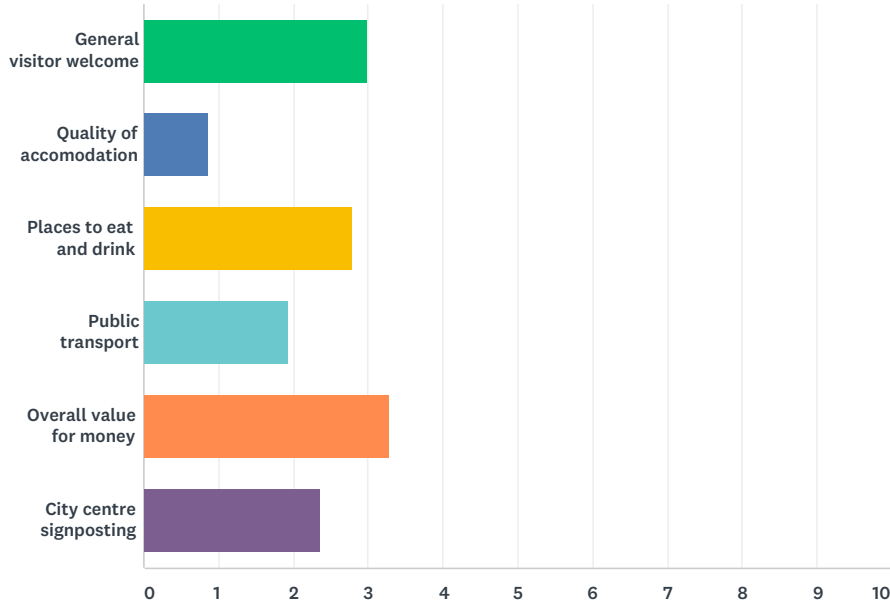

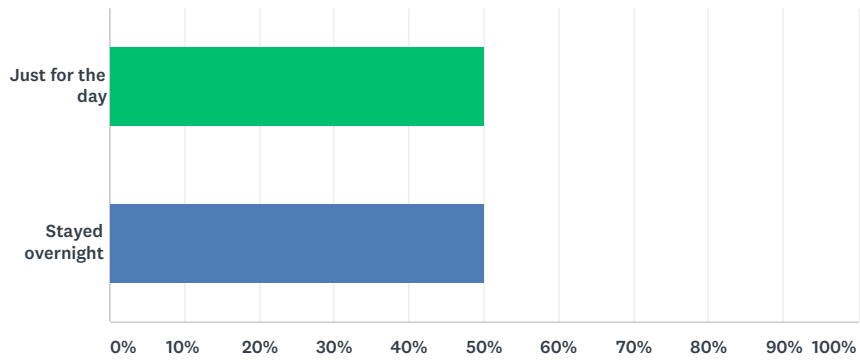

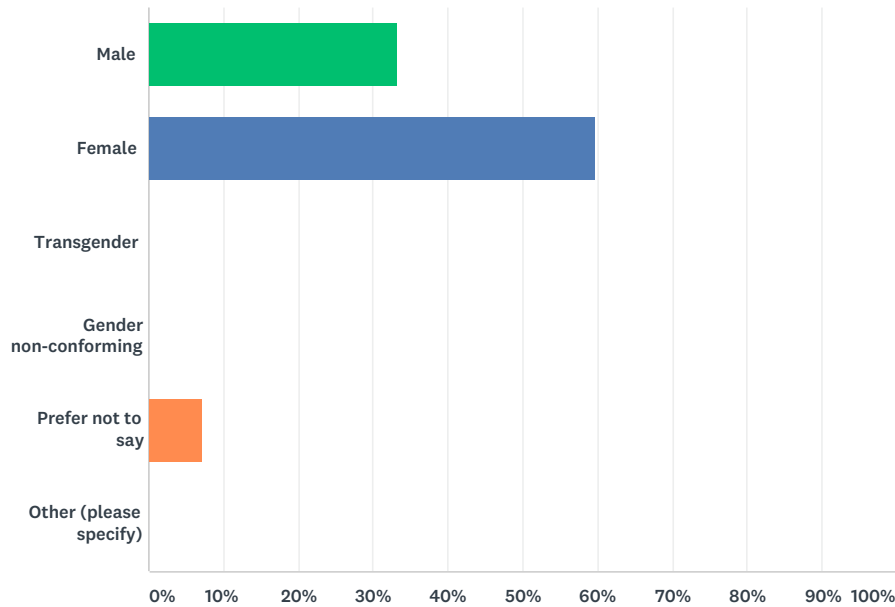

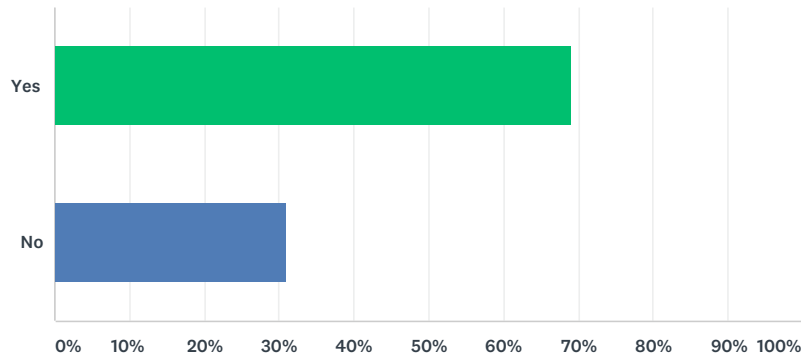
