The Show

Aftermath is an interactive journey from isolation to unity.

Taken from their comfort zone and left in isolation, audience must make their way through a dystopian world, in the aftermath of a massive societal trauma, witnessing snippets of the stories of their fellow travellers (through circus, theatre, music), and connecting and collaborating with other audience they encounter on the journey to build a brighter future.

Aftermath is a co-production with Roundhouse, and Theatre Delicatessen in association with Jacksons Lane, Seachange Arts, The Point Eastleigh, The National Centre for Circus Arts & Folke.



Considering the shockwaves through society in the wake of events like 9/11, the refugee crisis, and Brexit, we aim to combat the feeling that we are "too small to make a difference", empowering people to come together to process, redesign and construct a more utopian world.

Building on the trust we created with audience in our previous show "Shelter me" where audience were physically entrusted with the performer's safety and were implicated in moving the action of the show forward, we will engender trusting collaborative relationships not only between performer and audience but also amongst the audience themselves. The cast will serve sometimes as performers and sometimes as guides, in a show where audience become as integral in the narrative as the performers.
