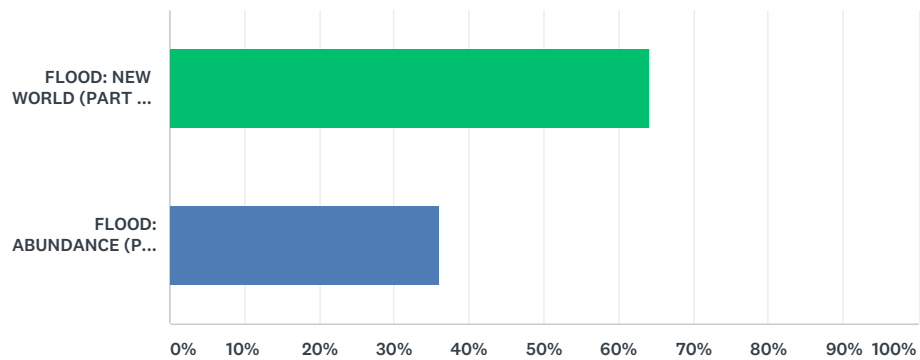

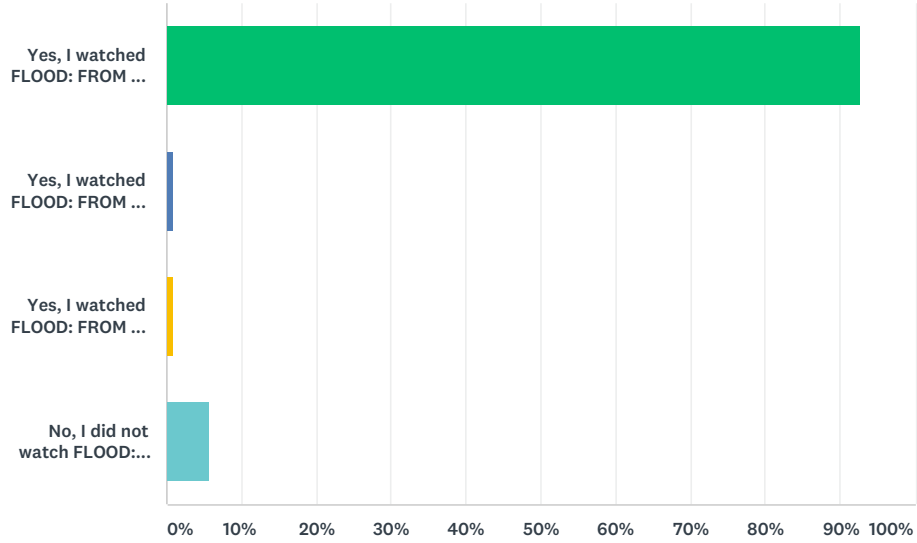

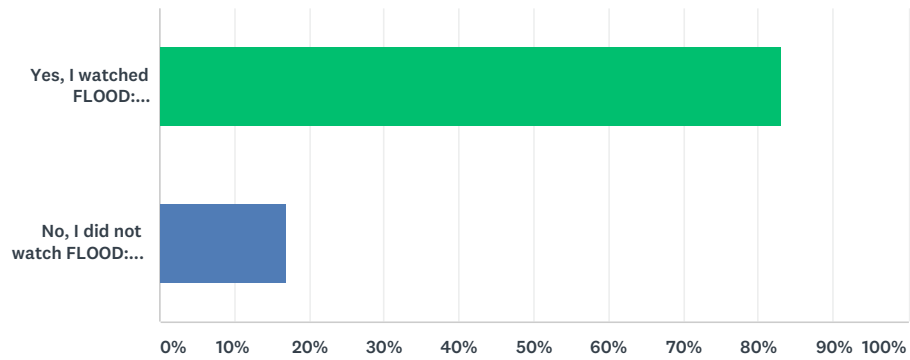

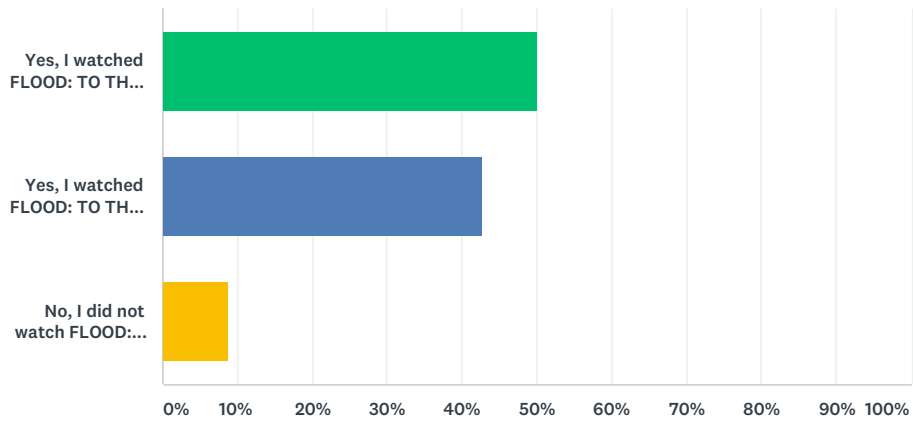

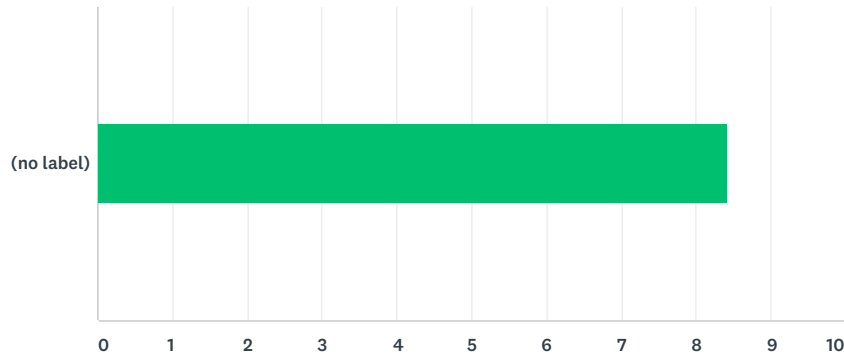

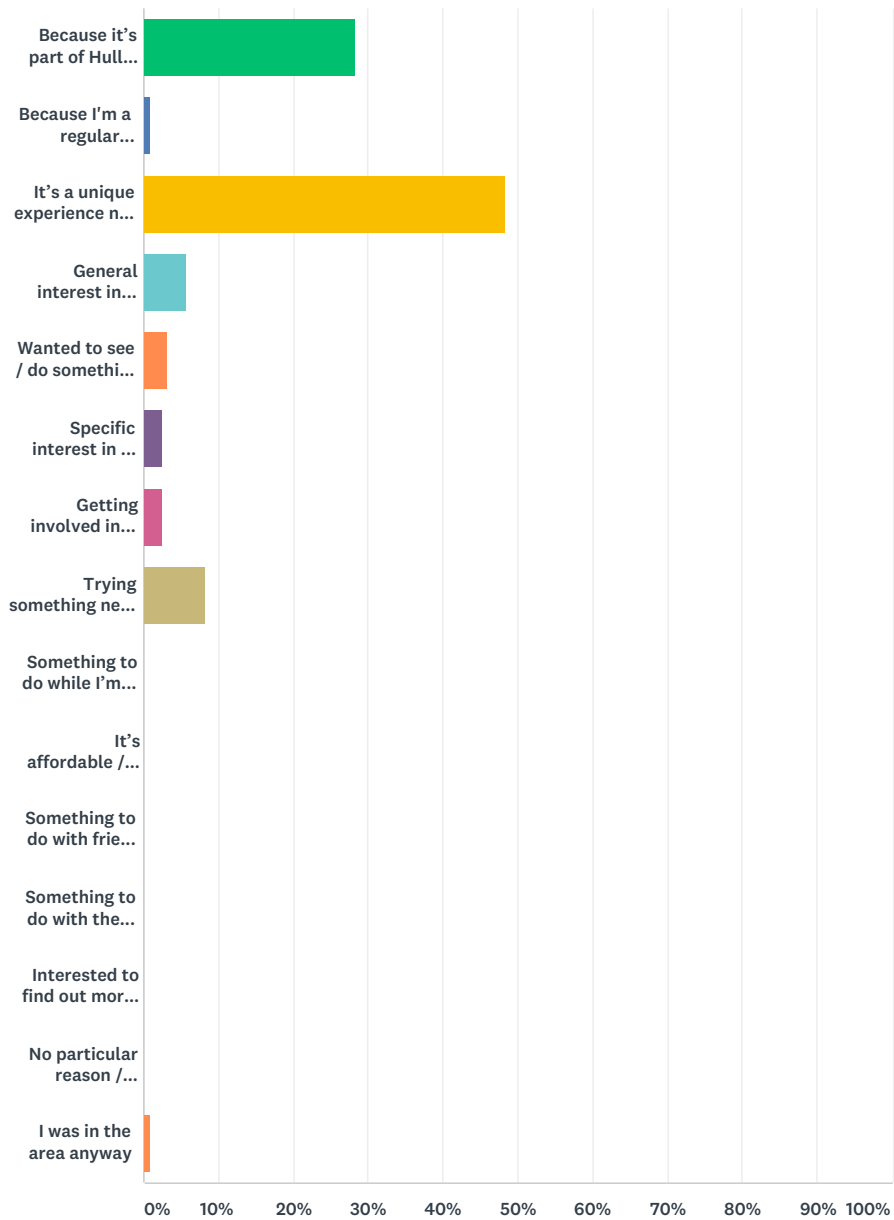

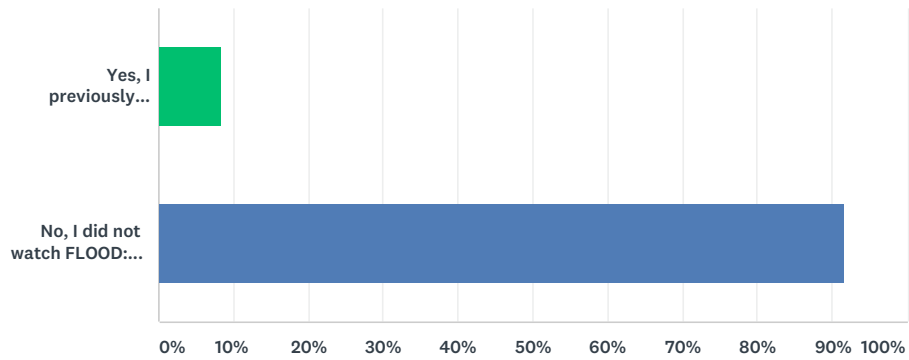

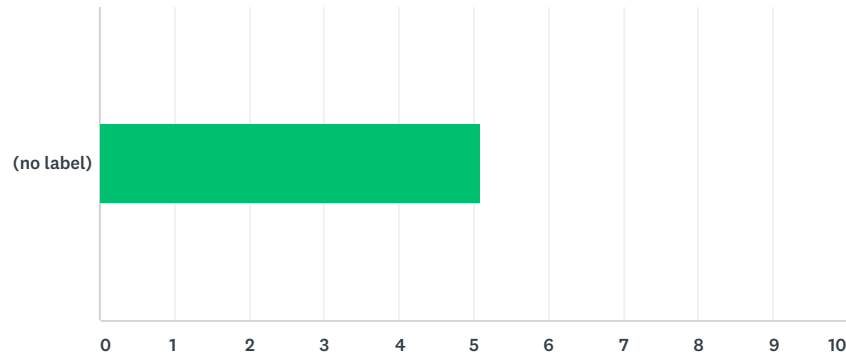

Q27 Do you live in Hull?

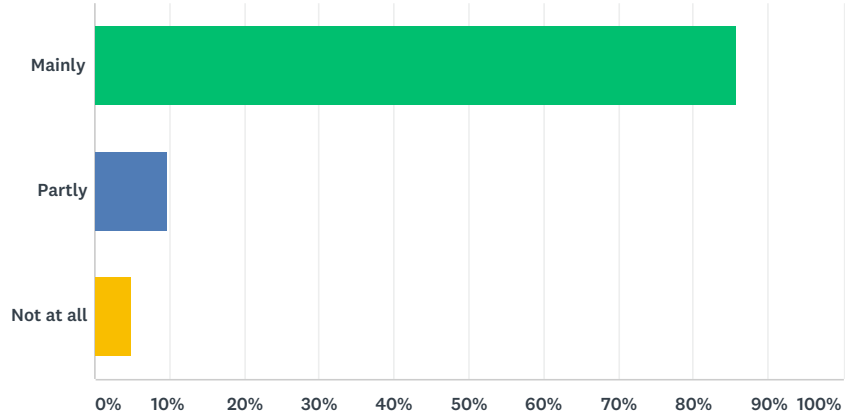

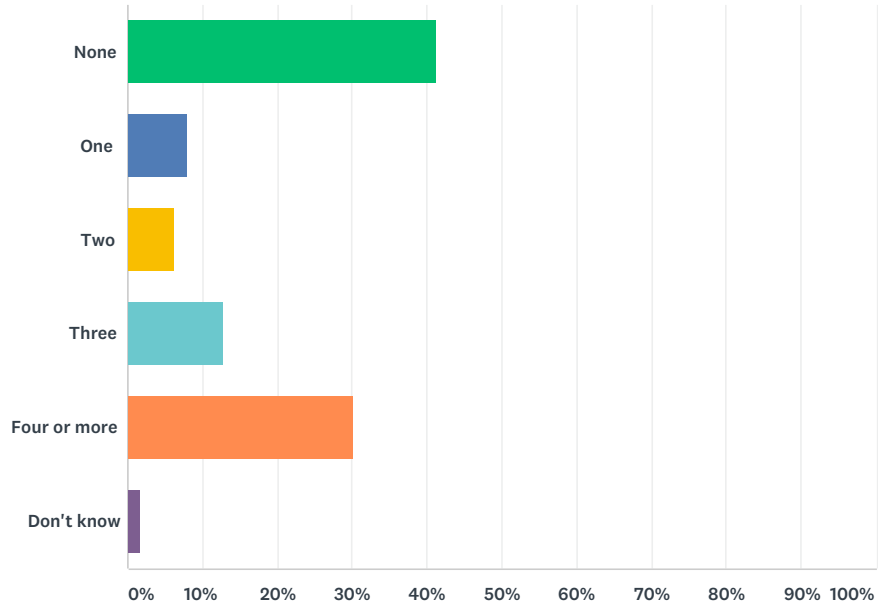

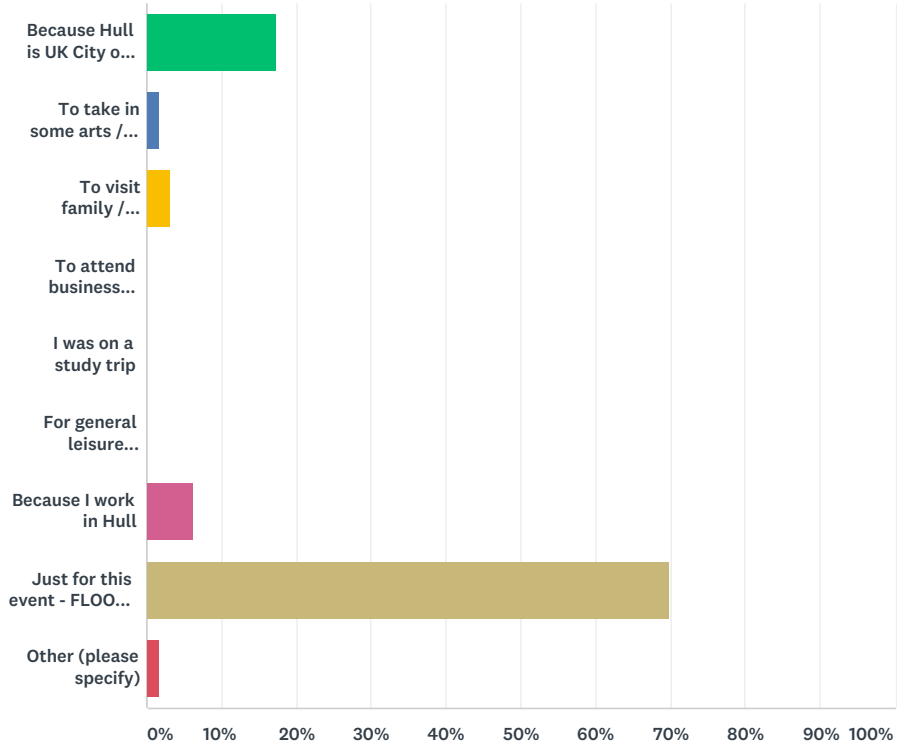

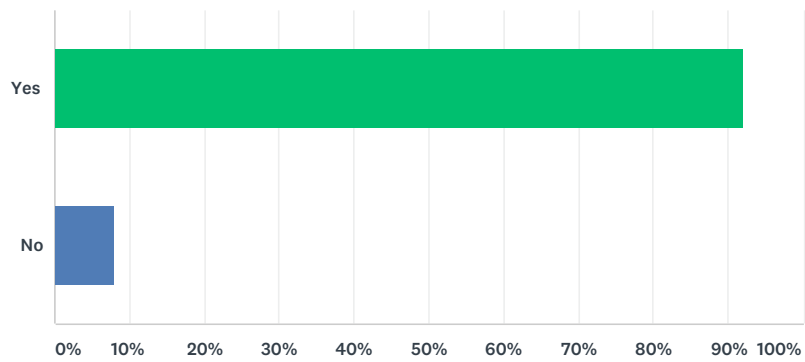

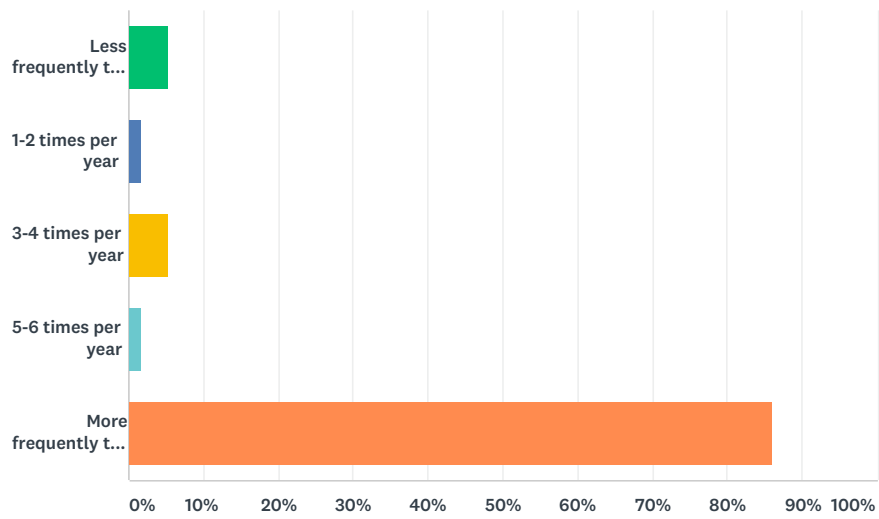

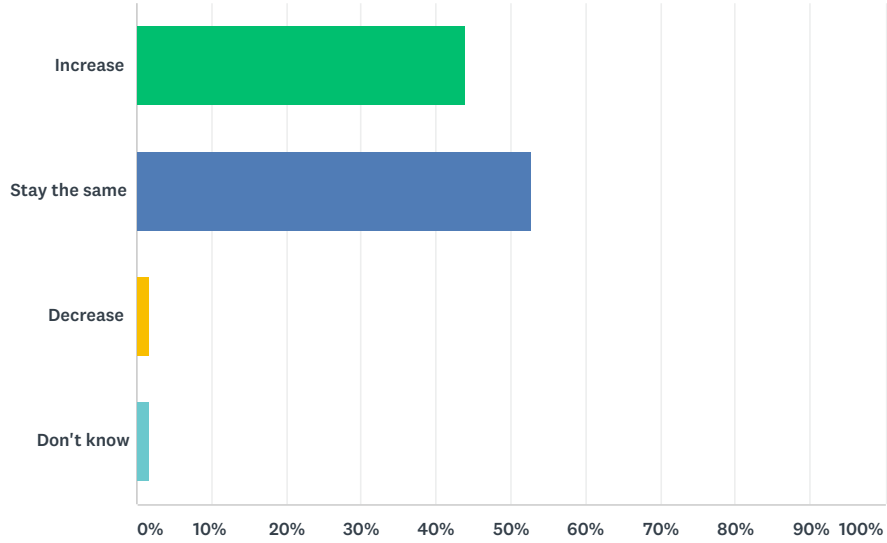

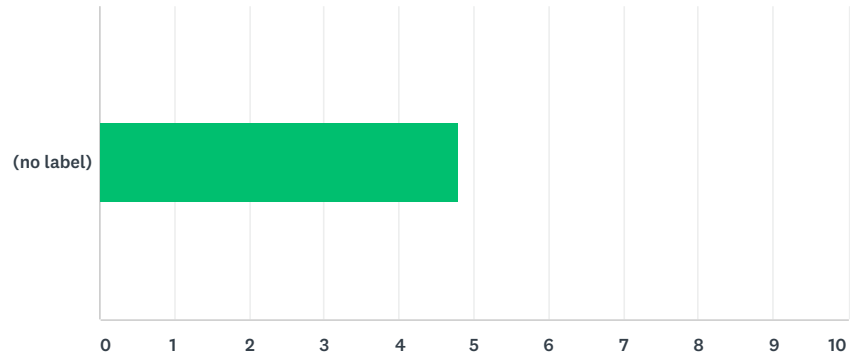

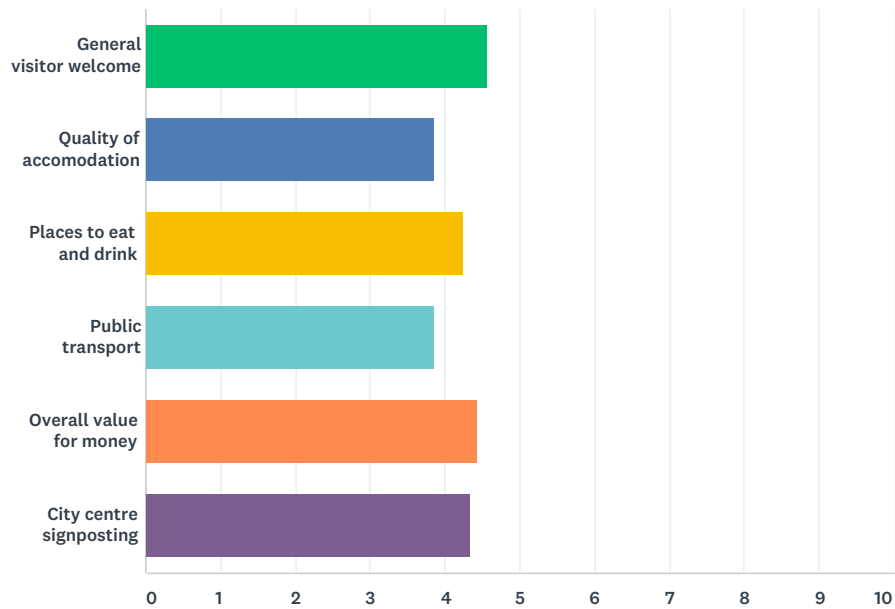

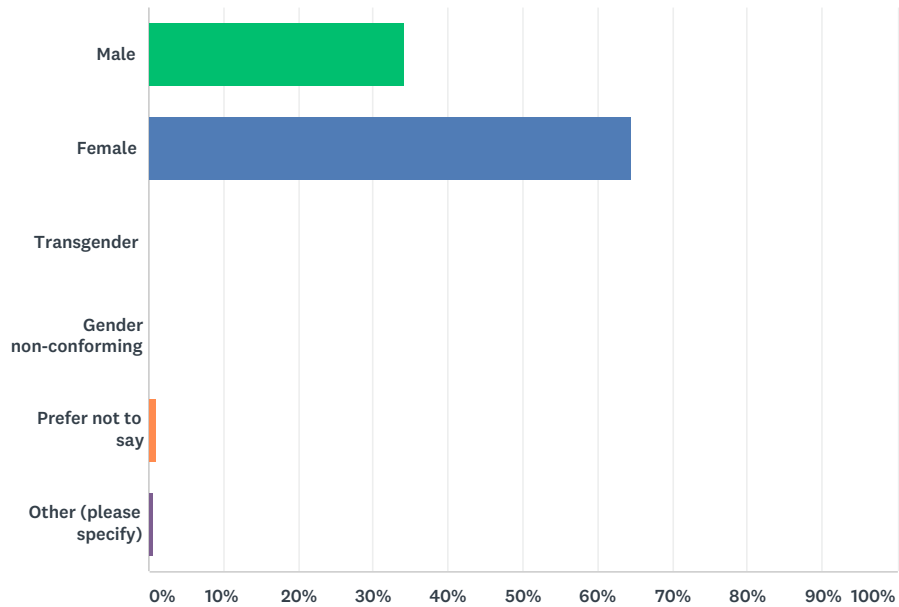

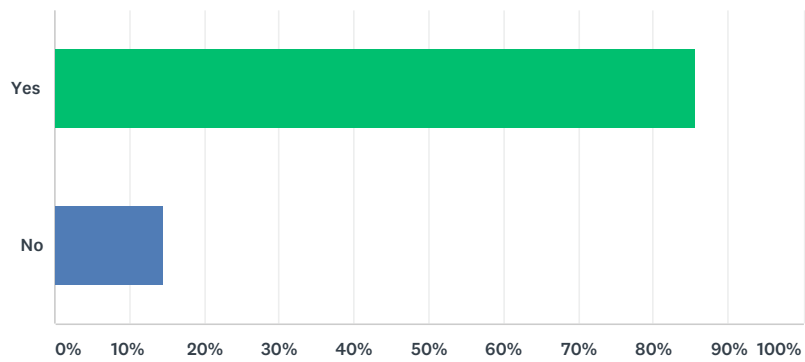
