Venue Notes (load in / performance space / load out)

We opted to perform in the theatre studio instead of the conference room since there was much more space. There were also no windows and LX pipes rigged in the ceiling so we hung our FOH lighting from the pipes in the space and used the stands for the upstage rig only.

Venue staff were onsite all day and were exceptionally helpful with everything we needed.

We ran out of free sheets from City of Culture this evening. Sarah will print more for our show tomorrow.

Performance Notes (acting notes, audience reaction etc)

Today we had a BSL interpreter at the show interpreting for some of the audience who were deaf/hard of hearing. She stood downstage right throughout the show and then followed Andrew into the audience during the drowning moment.

Another energetic show this evening.

Again, it took our audience a while to get into their ponchos and Andrew really had to shout over the ruckus to carry on with the show.

We had a number of young children in the audience again who were all about blowing bubbles and spraying Andrew with the water guns. Andrew got sprayed pretty good this evening.

Overall, the show was very well received by our audience tonight and the company got several lovely compliments on their way out.

Technical Notes (operator notes, items fixed / to be fixed)

We are going through ponchos very quickly - a lot of them are getting damaged each show. We will be able to get through tomorrow but will definitely need additional ponchos starting Monday.

Again, the cubicle door isn't staying closed or latched. Russ, I think the metal pipes don't secure snugly enough into the base so the sides pull apart slightly when the cubicle is moved. Any suggestions on how to remedy this?

The tupperware container covering the light in the cubicle has come off. It will need to be re-glued. Adam, could we snag your glue gun tomorrow?
