Culture project shows rude messages

AN art installation has sparked a flood of complaints after flashing up rude messages.

The City Speaks, a project on

Hull's tidal barrier, converts what people say on a microphone on the dockside into scrolling text.

But locals said software is failing to filter out offensive words from mickey-takers.

Messages on the panel, part of Hull's City of CURSED Panel on tidal barrier Culture year, have

included "send nudes" and "big hairy man hammock". Vicky Owens, 34, said: "It said 'ejaculation', then all sorts. It was bizarre.

"You have to admit it's funny. But if I have my kids with me, it becomes a different issue."

Ben McKnight, communications

director for Hull 2017, said: "There is a filter in place to block offensive words."

Andrew Knight, who curated the city's Look Up project, said at the launch of The City Speaks in February: "As time goes on, the software will get

better. But we trust the people of Hull to use this as intended."
