

The world renowned arts prize comes to Hull, offering the chance for everyone to encounter some of the most vibrant visual art being made today in an exciting exhibition of the four shortlisted artists' work.

The Turner Prize, named after British landscape painter JMW Turner, is an annual prize awarded by Tate to a British artist under the age of 50 who has exhibited outstanding work in the previous year.

Ferens Art Gallery will be only the fifth venue outside London to host the prize since it was established in 1984. Often provocative, the prize aims to promote debate around contemporary visual arts. Previous winners include Damien Hirst, Grayson Perry, Jeremy Deller and, in 2015, the collective Assemble.
