Poet Simon Armitage invites you to join him on a festive foray through 'God's Own Country' to the edge of the world.

Inspired by the language and landscape of West Yorkshire where he was born, Simon's latest collection, *The Unaccompanied*, looks beyond the region to larger global concerns.

Simon's acclaimed translation of the 14th-century quest narrative - *Sir Gawain and the Green Knight*, set in King Arthur's court at Camelot at Christmas - has sold over one hundred thousand copies.
