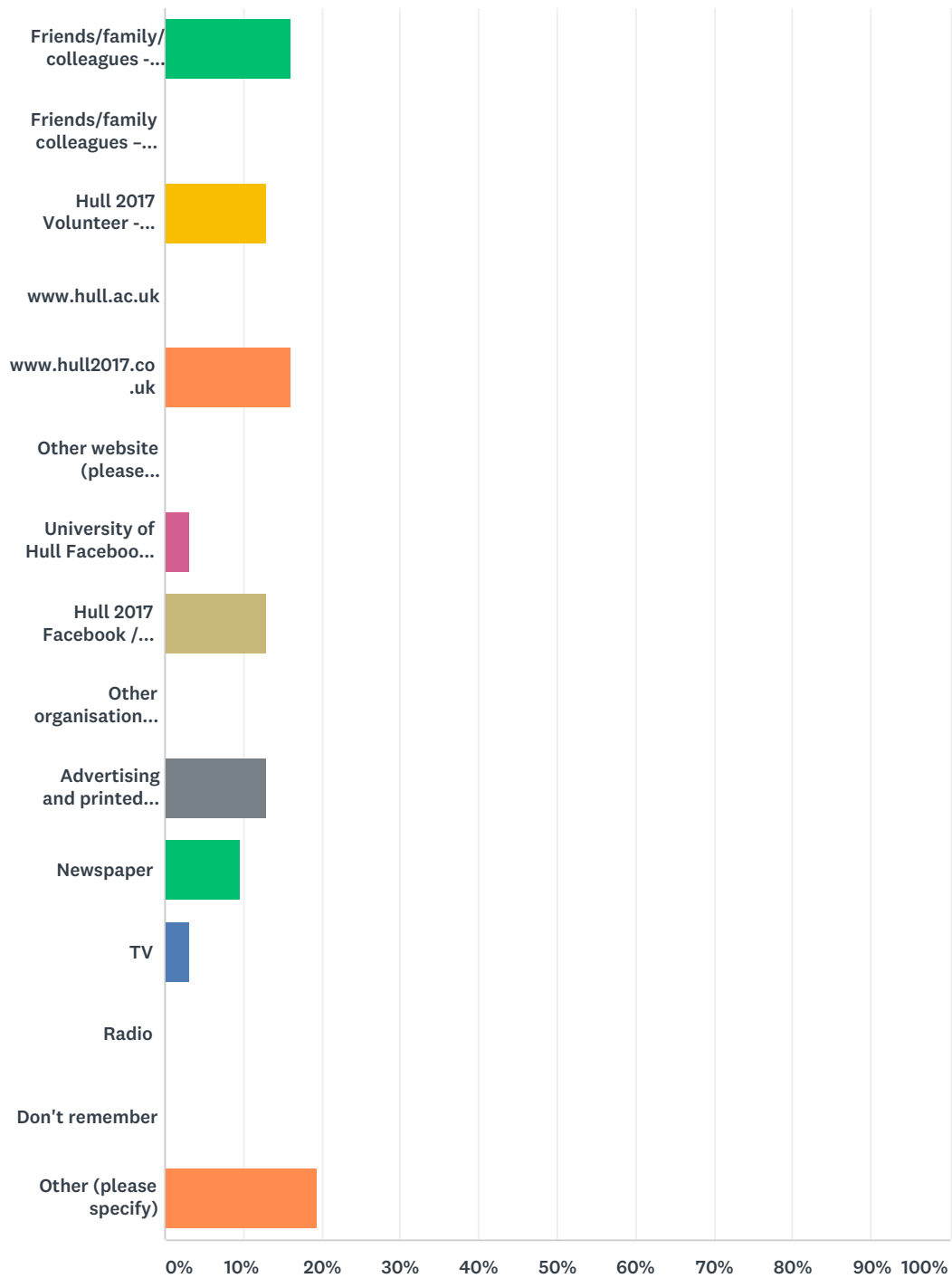

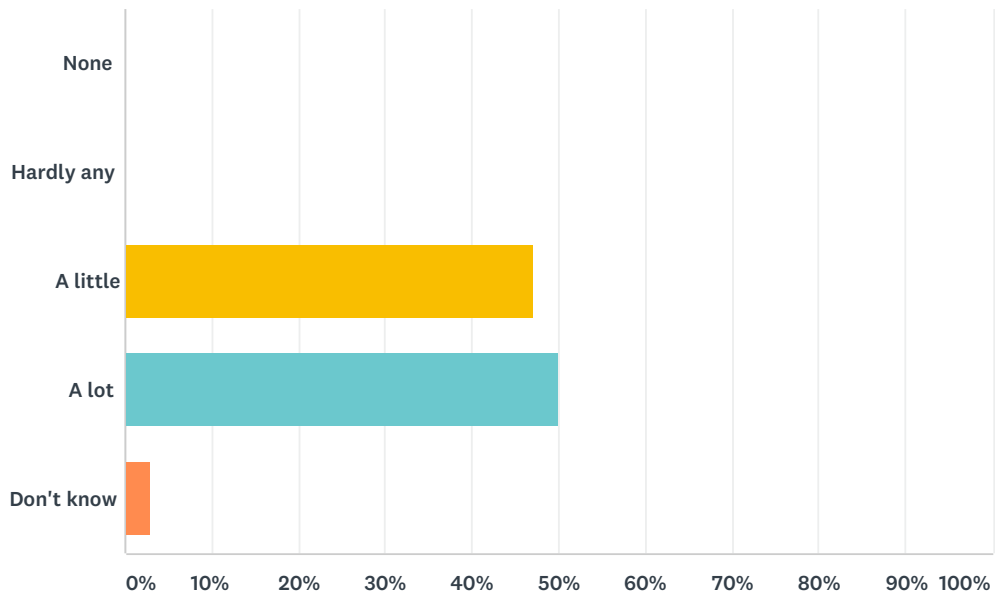

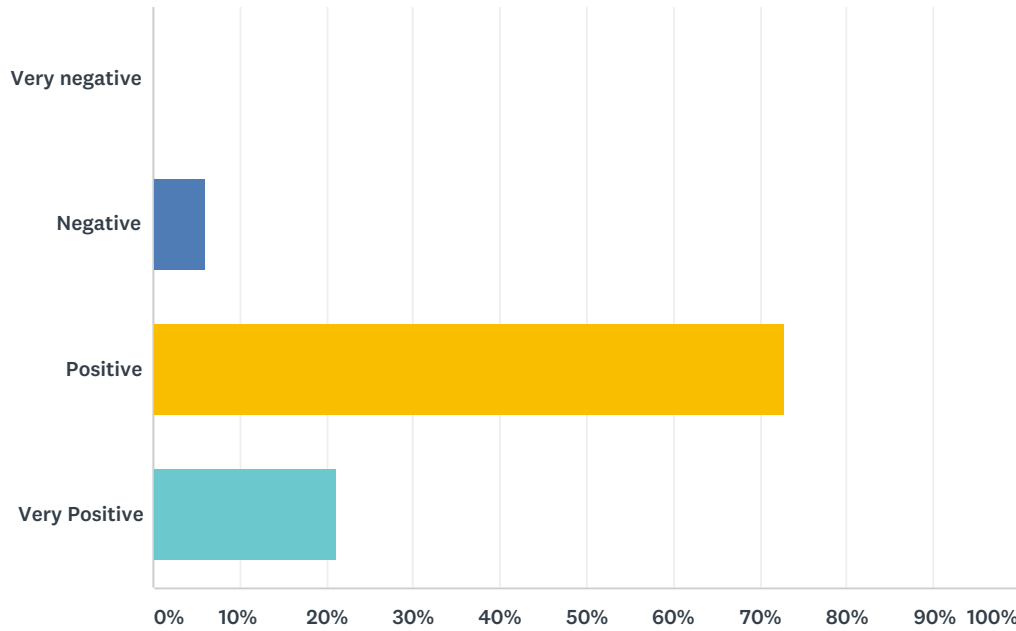

### Q5 Would you say your view of individuals who identify as disabled was positive or negative before attending this exhibition?

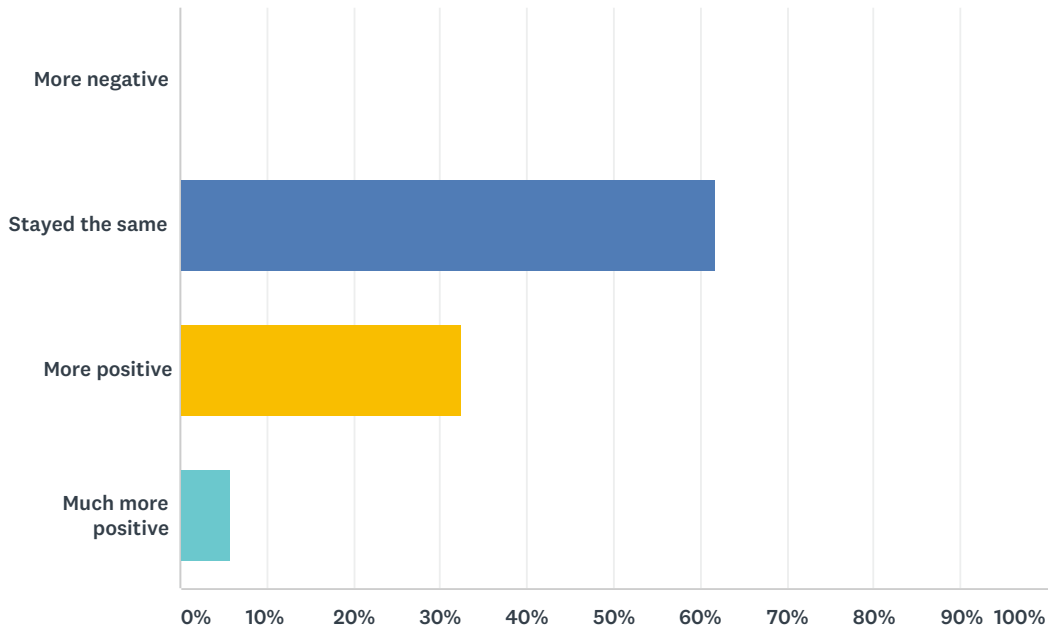

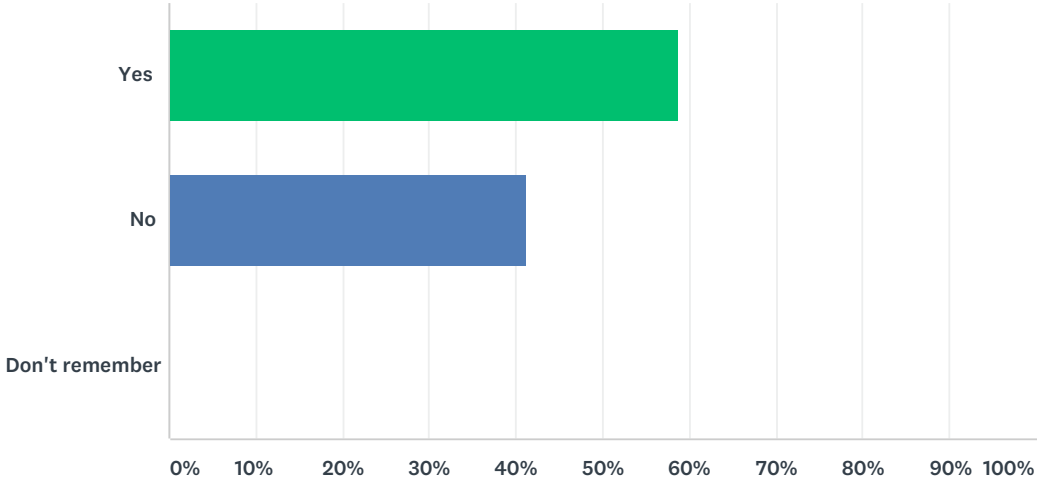

# Q7 In the last 12 months have you attended an event at the University of Hull?

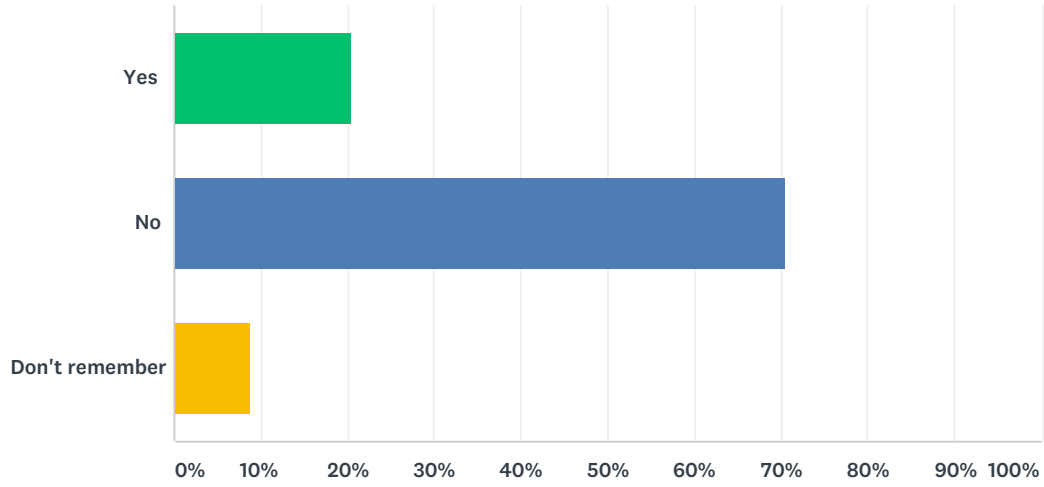

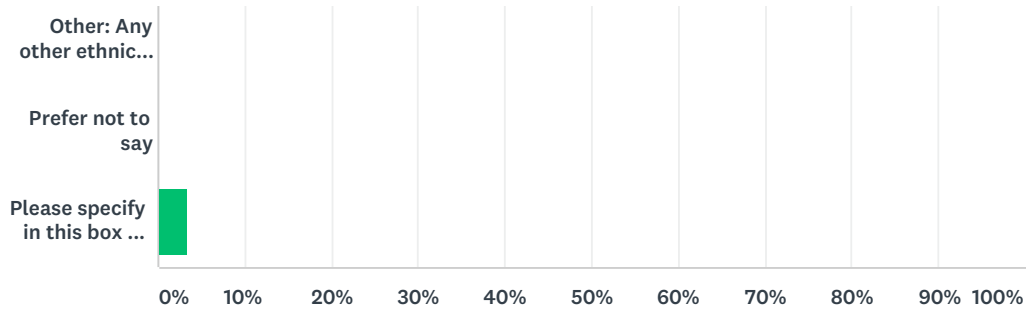

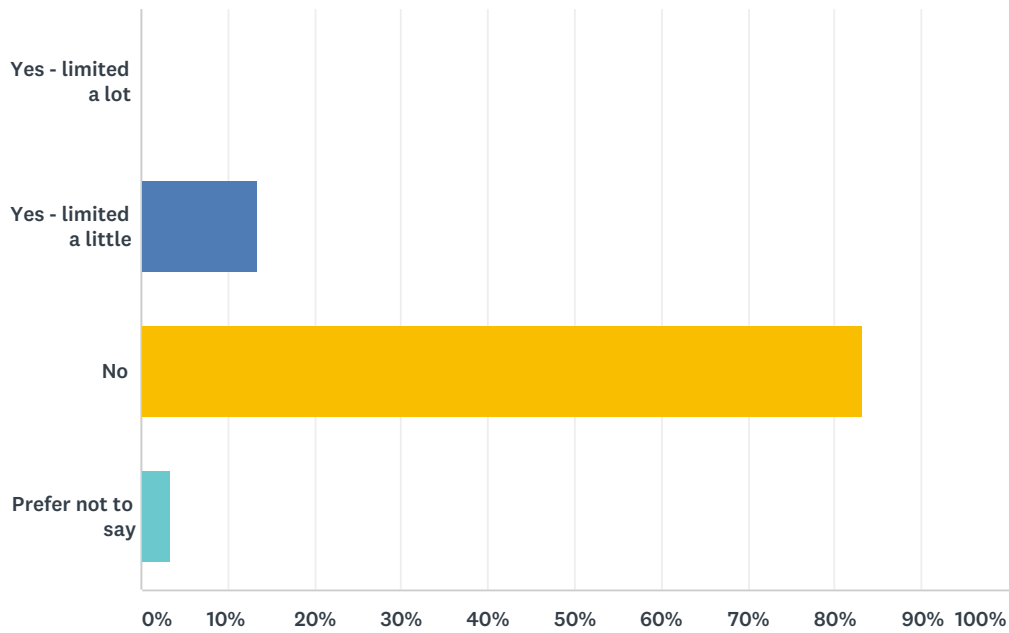

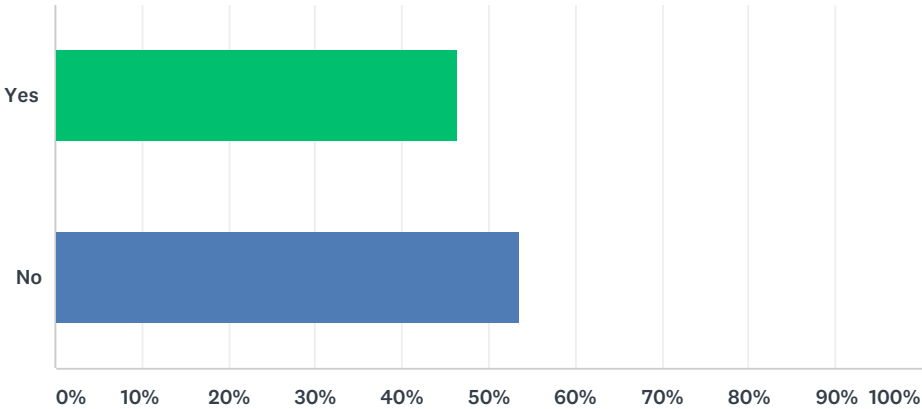
