### THE BOY WHO BIT PICASSO

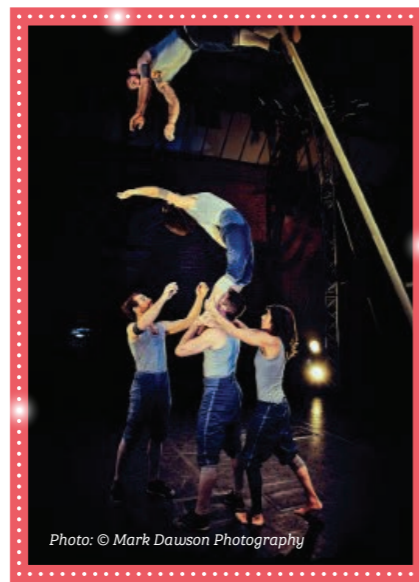

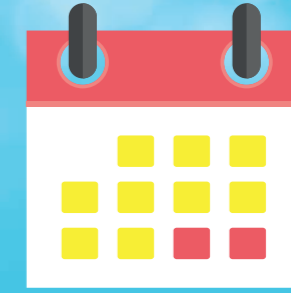
## BANDS, BANDS, BANDS!
